



## Course Content

In preparation for the assessment, candidates should engage with a range of genres and types of texts, including fiction and non-fiction, essays, reviews, and articles. This study should include a focus on writers' use of language and style and the ways in which writers achieve effects and influence readers. Candidates should study how influence may include facts, ideas, perspectives, opinions, and bias.

As developing writers themselves, candidates should be introduced to a range of skills – including the ability to compare, summarise and change perspective. They should develop the skills of summarising within the context of the following text types: letter, report, newspaper report, magazine article, journal, words of a speech. They should also learn to create a discursive/argumentative letter or article and a descriptive or narrative composition.

The topics for Year 10 IGCSE Thai First Language include:

- ❖ Reading comprehension and analysis (short story: Archaeological Tales)
- ❖ Constructive writing (writing an argument)
- ❖ Thai verse (meaning and continuous writing)
