## Uniform code of Conduct for Satit Prasarnmit International Programme (Reviewed June 2017)

The uniform code is with the constraints of the "Uniform code of Satit Prasarnmit Demonstration School but adapted to suit the needs of the International Programme Students.

Students are expected to wear the prescribed dress every school day except on designated special days. The dress is in effect during school from 7:30 am to 4:00 with the exception of sports and special permission and must worn be correctly whilst on school property.

All clothing items must fit properly, be clean and be pressed with no holes, tears or frayed areas.

As long as permission has been granted by a senior member certain mitigating circumstances will be accepted i.e. religious purposes.

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## PE Uniform

The P.E. uniform is to be worn for P.E. classes but students are allowed to arrive to school in their P.E. uniform if they have P.E. that day.

Students are advised to bring their school uniform with them on the day they have P.E. to change into after class. This advisement is due to the following reasons: hygiene purposes, wet condition or damages to clothing items during sport.

Furthermore all students must bring a spare pair of socks with them to school on the day they have a P.E. lesson.

## Military student uniform

Under advisement from Satit Prasarnmit Demonstration School, all students participating are obligated to wear the standard military uniform as below, during the day of participation in military training.

- Hair style:
  - Year 1-3: top and front hair less than 4 cm
  - Year 4-5: top and front hair less than 7 cm
- Beret (hat) - worn outdoors whilst indoors should keep in shoulder strap.
- Olive green, v neck collar under shirt should be worn at all times.
- Long sleeve green Satit Prasarnmit field shirt. Always Keep Shirt tucked in trousers.
- Military standard trousers
- Trousers bottoms should be tucked into military boots.
- Military student belt

## Permitted whilst at school.

- Remove long sleeve green Satit Prasarnmit field shirt
- Visible under shirt must be tucked in.
- Trousers bottoms should be tucked into military boots

## Manner of Dress

**ACCEPTED STANDARDS OF MODESTY AND NEATNESS WILL ENSURE THAT STUDENT DRESS AND APPEARANCE IS APPROPRIATE AND NON-OFFENSIVE IN A SCHOOL SETTING.**

All items of school clothing should fit properly and appropriately (shirts, blouse, shorts and skirts).

## Note:

A senior staff member will make the final judgment on inappropriate items of clothing.

The dress code is in effect on all school days from 7:00 A.M. to 4:00 P.M

Uniform is school property therefore any action undertaken whilst in school uniform will come under the constraints of the discipline policy.



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## Violation of Dress Code and Appearance Regulations

- All staff members are responsible for the administration of dress regulations. Questionable situations will be referred to senior staff.
- Dress code or appearance violations can be recorded by any member of staff.
- Demerits should be issued if the infringements are repeated.
- All students whose dress consistently does not conform to the school code will be referred by his/her teacher to the Key Stage Coordinators or Head of Discipline.
- If repeated and consistent violations occur the student's parents/guardian will contact and advised of the need to modify the student's attire
- If the student needs to be sent from campus to change clothes, the classes he/she misses during this absence will be regarded as unexcused.
- Disciplinary actions for violations of the dress code will include in-school, after-school detentions, the loss club privileges, internal suspension and suspension.
