



## Introduction

The Year 7 English (ESL) Course Curriculum will focus on all of the language skills: Reading, Writing, Listening, Speaking and Pronunciation Skills.

Students will begin Term 2 focusing on Unit 14: Local Community: developing an idea of what makes a community/neighborhood. We learn about the following topics: Shops and services, Town and country, and learn what a community is and why it is important to be a part of one. In the second half of the term, we will concentrate on Unit 16: The Silk Road which focuses on the historical journeys that took place including traditional stories that link back to the central Asian countries. They will also continue to develop their grammar skills with weekly classes focusing on a range of structures.

For grammar, we will integrate the following: *if* clauses which focus on predictions and possibility, countable/uncountable nouns (*some, much, many*), and articles (*a/an, the*).
