Course Content

Term 2 concluding with the end of the major unit on the Roman Empire and a sub-unit on the Dark Ages and the lead-in to the next major unit.

Term 3 will begin with the events of the Norman Conquest of 1066 and Duke William the Conqueror's role in ushering the Middle Ages that students have grown familiar with. Such themes of this period of time will be the trials and tribulations of life, the system of feudalism used to manage the emerging kingdoms, and the technology of the day and age.

The second half term will move into the Tudor period of the late middle ages, highlighting the various Tudor monarchs and their legends. Side topics during the study of the middle ages will consist of the Black Death, the Crusades, Henry VIII and the legend of Robin Hood. This will lead nicely into year 8 history and the pre-industrial period.
