



Course Content

For Term 3, the focus will be on the Industrial Revolution. Students will learn what the Industrial Revolution was and how it shaped the world we have today. In addition, students will learn what important aspects made the Industrial Revolution a significant portion of our history. Areas that will be explored include the surge in population and the concept of urbanization. Connected to this is the rise of problems facing urbanization such as disease, housing changes, and pollution.

Other topics included in this term will be the explosion of new inventions, the powerhouse effect of coal and Iron, transportation (Eg. steamboats and railways), and the advantages and disadvantages integrated in this point in history.
