



Course Content

The aims for Year 9 TLC Term 3 are to enable learners to read a wide range of texts, improve fluently with good understanding, enjoyment, and appreciate a variety of language. In reading, students will demonstrate an understanding of how writers use language and structure to achieve effects and influence readers, analyze, evaluate, and develop facts, ideas and opinions. In writing, they will have a range of appropriate vocabulary, tone, style, and register appropriate to the audience and context.

The contents and topics for writing include an advertisement, finding the main idea (reading), King Rama V's speech (reading and analysis), and reading one short article about Thai farmers. The main writing assessment will include looking at the structure and the appropriate language required for advertisements. Students will also be taught numerous techniques to scan articles and find the theme quickly. They will be able to locate specific details in a text.
